# Some Tips

- □ Know which program you are in
- □ Check the requirements of your program
- Use the study plan
- U When you are developing your study plan, select courses you are interested in; and then for each course:
  - > Checking its availability; please note that some courses are NOT offered in every year
  - Checking its prerequisites (particularly for structure courses); it's the students' responsibility to make sure they have met all the prerequisites.
  - > Level 7 courses are generally the most constrained ones.
- Research project is 1-year or 1-semester long
- To help you perform better in your research project, you are encouraged to enrol in <u>CIVL7518: Research</u> <u>Methods for Engineers</u> (offered in Sem 2) in your first year if this is compatible with your program requirements.


